### I. Consent Agenda

### II. Administrative

- Annexations – review options – decision to use opportunities throughout 2021 to discuss with the identified landowners. Signatures on the petition should be received by September, 2021.

### III. Ag Water Board/Water Supply

- Deep Aquifer project – Dan reported that Chuck was still working on the water banking paper.
- AWB Grant – The Ecology grant to fund surface to ground conversions and stream augmentation needs a project on the ground next summer. AESI presented a few options in Dakota Creek. There are questions about the use of the deep aquifer well as the data developed may not be relevant to the Foster Pilot project which was one of the reasons for the grant. Ecology is looking into that. The Maberry well on Stein and the Ebe linear well to the east will be explored as options to augment the North Fork of Dakota. Dale will have a rough cost estimate ready for the January meeting. A temporary water right permit should be applied for by February.

### IV. Water Quality

- Monitoring Results – David noted samples in the WID were good throughout much of 2020 so he had not been doing much monitoring. Early December numbers were high in several areas though. The Board authorized David to take some followup samples to help identify the likely sources. The presence of large numbers of waterfowl certainly should be considered.
- DNA project – Avian project initiated

Meeting was adjourned at 3:53. Next meeting is January 19.
