• Water quality testing results are positive. We anticipate Drayton Harbor being opened to shellfish harvesting next spring.

## C. Water Quantity

- Planning Unit still meeting but County has no more support in the 2016 budget.
- Out of Stream Users Group expected to have an initial group meeting in December.
- Drought Preparation application Bill and Henry expect to submit to Ecology soon.

#### D. Update of WID Comprehensive Plan

- Puget Sound Partnership Local Integrating Agency Near Term Action list –
  Henry distributed an overview of a request for support for WID Plan development
  funding through the Puget Sound Partnership. This is an early draft of the scope
  and budget of the project.
- Comprehensive Plan Update mapping project Heather MK submitted a memo describing the opportunity for the WID to make use of some County grant dollars to do some mapping of the WID that could be used in the development of the WID Plan and in identifying areas where ag priorities and environmental priorities may provide opportunities for future projects. Agreeing with this proposal will require some board time at the December meeting and an agreement to get property owners involved when the priority mapping takes place in January/February. Greg moved to support the project, Jeff seconded, motion carried unanimously.

#### E. Education -

- Letter to members A draft of a letter explain the assessment rate increase was reviewed. Greg moved to send the letter as drafted, Rod seconded, motion carried unanimously.

## F. Other Items from Commissioners

• Greg brought up the idea of doing more deep aquifer exploration in the western portion of the WID. Hydrogeologists sense that the deep aquifer there may be refreshed by the Fraser with abundant amounts of clean water. He wondered if the WID would be interested in applying for grant funds to pursue this idea. It could be a direct source of water or used as mitigation water for Dakota and California Creeks. Greg will arrange a meeting to discuss this will Chuck Lindsay and Birch Bay Water. Henry will check on the potential of drought relief funds for this.
